Reflecting on 25 years

Since our founding in 1993, Flatirons Habitat for Humanity has worked to bring the benefits of homeownership to Boulder and Broomfield counties. **In 2018, as we celebrate our 25th anniversary, we're taking some time to reflect on why we do what we do.**

In the last quarter-century we have built, rehabilitated, or repaired more than 220 homes in the area. **With our help, hundreds of homeowners have opened new doors to [health, safety, and educational advancement](#).**

We also believe that providing options for affordable housing is strengthening the Boulder and Broomfield communities at large, and have worked to expand the scope of our work to meet heightened community needs. As housing prices in the area climb to unprecedented levels, **we have set a goal to aggressively grow our building capacity** over the next fiscal year. In 2018 alone, we plan to break ground on two new builds providing 21 total units of affordable housing.

We are incredibly proud of what we have accomplished so far. But we know that there is still work to do.

Looking to the future, we are guided by the grand vision of **a world where every single person has a safe, decent, and affordable place to live.** But we are also motivated by hundreds of more humble images: A quiet corner where a bright young mind can study. A sunny yard safe for playing outside. A kitchen where healthy, home-cooked meals are prepared.

We think that these small dignities cultivate happy, productive lives and strong communities. **So as we come up on 25 years of service, we're crafting a list of #25ReasonsWeBuild.** We already have some reasons in mind - but we'll also be borrowing ideas from Habitat homeowners, long-time volunteers, staff, and more.

Build Highlight: Boulder's Violet Ave. will feature 19 units of affordable housing



Flatirons Habitat for Humanity is thrilled to be **moving forward with our biggest-ever build: 19 units of affordable housing** off of Violet Ave. in Boulder. The construction plan for the proposed build site, which sits on an acre of unincorporated county land, **won approval from the Boulder Planning board in December 2017**, as well as approval for a proposal to amend the original annexation agreement for the parcel. That annexation amendment is going

before City Council in late February. Assuming the amendments are approved, our construction team hopes to be breaking ground by late 2018, with move-in for new residents beginning in late 2019.

The site will feature a combination of three-bedroom units designed for families and one-bedroom units intended for seniors. Flatirons Habitat will begin accepting applications for Violet Ave. homeowners this year. This site will target homeowners who make between 40 and 60 percent of area median income. For an eligible family of four in Boulder, for example, applicants' income would range between \$38,000 and \$57,000.

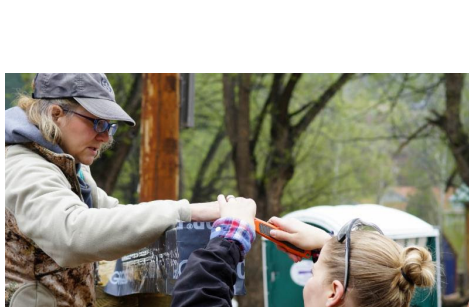

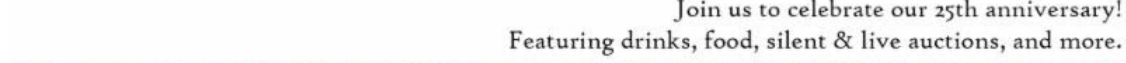
