Flatirons Habitat for Humanity and Lowe's invite women to build alongside future homeowners during the 10th annual National Women Build Week, May 6-14.

National Women Build Week brings together women to devote at least one day to building decent and affordable housing in their communities. Nearly 100,000 women from all 50 states have volunteered in previous years. Flatirons Habitat is one of 300 Habitat organizations nationwide hosting Women Build projects during the week with support from Lowe's, a longtime
